Home Learning Update: 26 March 2020

Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for your support with helping your son/daughter manage their home learning this week. There have naturally been some teething problems as we get used to a new system but we are very pleased with the way the students have adapted and focused on making the most out of learning opportunities at this difficult time.

In some cases students have been so dedicated that it has resulted in them spending much longer than intended on their assignments. Our expectation is that they do not spend longer than 1 hour per 'lesson' even if this means not completing all of their work. It is important that students continue to learn but also maintain the appropriate balance with maintaining their own emotional and physical well being. I have emailed students to reiterate this point and asked that they email their teacher if they find they cannot complete the work within 1 hour.

If students do not have regular access to a computer they are able to access the assignments on the Microsoft Teams mobile app and, if necessary, complete work on paper, photograph and attach to the assignment.
