



## Ways in Which Parents Can Support their Children

1. Asking your child to show you're their homework and checking via Show My Homework that they have completed it properly and to a high standard.
2. Ensuring that your child is fully equipped for Maths lessons, including a pen, pencil, ruler, rubber, sharpener, protractor and calculator. Scientific calculators are for sale in the Maths faculty for £5.50.
3. Asking your child to explain the mathematics they have been learning about in any given week and asking them to teach you something you do not know to test their understanding of it.
4. Encouraging your child to respond to teacher marking by correcting mistakes and acting on any feedback given, such as targets and actions that have been suggested by the teacher.
